Tips to Determine if your Fiberglass Vendor is Supplying a Quality Product

Rather than wait until you and your customer are disappointed in a fiberglass planter, there are easy ways to determine in advance if it is made properly or improperly:

You can feel the difference.

First, lift the product. If it feels surprisingly heavy, it could be made with filled resin, which adds weight, but makes the product more brittle. Next, run your hand down the outside surface of the product and check for lumps or waves. If you feel them, then very likely the manufacturer has either used off-spec resin, inadequate equipment and/or improper production techniques. The result is a product which could fail at any time before, during or after installation. If you feel the surface of our products, they will be smooth, and that is what you want in a fiberglass product.

You can see the difference.

Inside — Look inside the container. If you see sloppy strips of glass mat, often accompanied by globs of resin, it is certain that improper equipment and inadequate production techniques have been used to make the product.

Outside — Even if a fiberglass planter is made improperly, when a highly-reflective, glossy finish is applied, the surface waves are difficult to see. If a matte finish or a lighter finish is applied, the waves in an improperly made product normally can be seen. This, of course, is undesirable for both you and your customers. We are proud to show our products in any and all finishes since the surface is smooth and always portrays a top quality image.
